

# Ginger

## Kentucky Bluegrass

- Excellent emergence & seeding vigor
- Early maturity variety
- Aggressive rhizomes for outstanding coverage

Kentucky Bluegrass is long-lived, with underground rhizomes, resulting in dense sod. It is a highly palatable pasture grass. Ginger has excellent early spring green-up and forage production - almost a month earlier than many other bluegrass varieties. It is tolerant of close grazing, and is palatable and nutritious for all livestock - horses included.
